



Publishing a new book is a significant event in any author's career, especially when venturing into a new genre. Harold Emanuel, well known for his cozy mysteries, just launched a historical novel, **Aliyah – A Jewish Family Saga.** The tale begins when 16-yearold Lazar Hermanski and his brother, 12-year-old Mendel, escape the 1881 Christmas Day pogrom, travel to America in steerage, and begin a new life on Manhattan's Lower East Side.




The Hermanski family's saga extends beyond their own lives, intertwining with key historical events like the building of the Brooklyn Bridge, the 1899 Newsies strike, the General Slocum disaster, the Triangle Shirtwaist factory fire, and the sinking of the Lusitania. They cross paths with notable figures such as Teddy and Edith Roosevelt, Jack Johnson, Fiorello LaGuardia, Fanny Brice, and Al Smith, adding depth and historical accuracy to the narrative.

Linda Bleser's **Heaven and Lace** will be available November 14th. This sweet romance story is about a bestselling romance novelist Lace Kincaid, who is the darling of the romance industry, at the top of her game, and about to receive the prestigious Crystal Quill award.
